



Decision no. 20 of the Executive Committee

Date: May 13, 2025

Regarding: Approval of the EFC calendar for the new 2025/2026 season.

§ 1

Following the procedure described in the EFC Administrative Rules, the Executive Committee approved the EFC Calendar for the new season 2025/2026.

The following improvements and changes were accepted:

1. There was a lot of confusion with U23+ / 023FEE and U23. In order to tackle this, the Bureau proposes to call the open category "Eurofence League" and the "closed" category U23 - this will streamline the process and allow clear rankings to be established. The Bureau also believes that having categories with the same name and different rules does not allow for a clear branding.
2. Considering the narrow calendar, we would like to propose, that competitions can be considered in more than one category - e.g. a Satellite could also count as Eurofence competition.
3. In order to increase the quality of our events we will start implementing, some clear rules commencing with rules of branding and - once the competitions commission has finished its work started in Munich more rules will be added. These rules will start with basic requirements like streamlined schedule and minimum spacing allowing every organiser to improve at a reasonable and achievable rhythm.
