Jerusalem Championships

Dear Member Federations,

In order to allow a smooth weapon control in Jerusalem we kindly ask you to follow the below procedure:

- 1) Delegations must deliver their equipment in a bulk way.
- 2) Delegations must fill out the form PRIOR to presenting themselves to control
- 3) All equipment must be handed over in a bag containing only equipment marked on the form.
- 4) The following gear will be controlled at weapon control:
 - a. Mask (max 2 per fencer)
 - b. Glove (max 2 per fencer)
 - c. Lamé (conductive vest) (max 2 per fencer)
 - d. Weapons (max 4 per fencer)
- 5) Reception of equipment will be acknowledged by the staff at the weapon control, you will be given a number (marked on the original of your form)
- 6) After your bag passed control your number will be posted on a dashboard – please present yourself for pickup only after your number has been posted.
- 7) We would like to draw your attention that while **the absence of the name in the back will be tolerated for cadets** it won't for the juniors! Besides that exception equipment must at any time be fully FIE-compliant.
