Kovács Gergely (men's epée) Introduction, CV

My name is Gergely Kovács, I was born on April 28, 2003 in Mór. I grew up in Székesfehérvár, and I first came into contact with sports as a kindergartener. We went to skating school with my group of kindergarteners. At the end of the course, I was selected for the beginner ice hockey team.

In 2010, our family moved to Germany and there I had the opportunity to play ice hockey in Bietigheim with the Steelers youth team. We achieved smaller and bigger successes with the team, but after a few years it turned out that this would not be my sport. I also tried swimming. At that time, my father was already working as a fencing coach in a fencing club in Ditzingen and I accompanied him to one of his trainings and I got stuck there, I fell in love with epée fencing.

We moved back to Hungary in 2016. I continued my fencing career in Székesfehérvár at the Alba Regia Fencing Academy. I managed to get into the national team already in the cadet age group, which I was able to continue as a junior, where I managed to win the Hungarian championship title three times in a row.

Since 2022, I have been a student at ELTE University, majoring in business management. Currently I compete for my Club in Tatabánya.

In 2024, I won the silver medal at the U23 European Championships, and we managed to bring home the gold medal as a team. This year, in 2025, I had the opportunity to fence with the senior national team, we won the World Cups in Bern and Vancouver. As a second-year senior fencer, my main goal is to be among the top 12 in the Hungarian rankings, to compete in international competitions, World Cups, GPs, and the goal is to be a member of the U23 national team.


