## Information Letter no. 15-2021

Dear Member Federation,

we are starting the EFC Master List update procedure which will be applicable in the next season (2021/2022). The criteria are almost the same as it was established last year. Because the last season was extraordinary the EFC Executive Committee extended the last criterium from two to three years.

According to the EFC Administrative Rules



(page no. 16) criteria are:

## **Master List**

- Proposal send by the NF, ranked for each weapon;
- Maximum 9 referees in all weapons but no more than 3 referees per each weapon with minimum 2 FIE licenses.
- FIE category ("A" or "B");
- Gender equality (Maximum 6 referees with one gender).
- In exceptional situations EFC Referees Commission can propose changes in the applications, after consulting with a federation and obtaining its consent.
- Only referees who participated on minimum one FIE tournament in last three seasons can be proposed to EFC Master List.

All Federations are kindly requested to submit their applications to the General Secretariat (e-mail address: <a href="mailto:js@fencing-efc.eu">js@fencing-efc.eu</a>) on "Master List form" which has been attached to this letter.

The deadline for submitting applications is: September 20, 2021.

## Do not miss the deadline because applications submitted after the deadline will not be considered.

Please let me remind you that referees selection process for European Championships remains the same. We will continue recruiting referees from national federations' applications. However the EFC Referees Commissions has the right to propose replacements to the EFC Executive Committee when the list of proposed referees does not guarantee appropriate and sufficient quality of refereeing during championships.
