Proposal for a change in the statutes to improve gender balance in the European Fencing Confederation

For modern sport, gender equality is increasingly important. In the EU and for many governments the ability of a sport organisation to work systematically with questions of equal opportunities is continously evaluated. There are also many real advantages to be gained in the organisation of a sport by ensuring participation from both sexes.

The EFC should be proactive in this development. We should have representation of both sexes on all levels and in all functions of fencing organisations. Ideally, the representation should be balanced. This would encourage more women to get engaged on an organisational level of fencing and mobilise more resources in the development of our sport.

In the IOC, in the FIE, in the EFC and in many national federations, guaranteed places for the underrepresented sex have proven effective to create a better balance.

At the moment, one place is guaranteed for the minority gender in the EFC COMEX. This should be increased to two and representation of both sexes should be secured in the EFC commissions.

We propose to change the statutes to the following wording:

Amend art. 12.2

The Executive Committee must include at least two one women and two one men.

Amend art. 12.7

If the nine (9) highest amounts of votes in the Executive Committee election do not include a minimum of two (2) are for candidates of the same both genders, eight (8) seven (7) candidates with the highest amounts of votes and a two (2) persons of the opposite gender having obtained the highest amount of votes are elected.

Amend art. 17.3

The Commissions normally consist of up to 6 (six) members, representing different Member Federations. A minimum number of one (1) member of each gender must be included. In the election of Commission members the same principle as per art 12.7 is applied.
